



# Oberwolfach Leibniz Fellows

- + Spend 1-3 months as an Oberwolfach Leibniz Fellow (OWLF) at the MFO with full board and lodging.
- + Take advantage of our infrastructure to pursue your own research project.
- + Establish new contacts with top researchers in your field.
- + Collaborate with up to three other researchers for 1-4 weeks each.
- + Participate in other programs during your stay: Workshops, Mini-Workshops, Seminars and Arbeitsgemeinschaften (study groups).
- + Visit other universities or research centers during your fellowship (1-2 weeks).
- + Obtain travel support and scholarship support, possibly in combination with a postdoc position elsewhere.

## Apply now

Applications can be made anytime and will be decided within two months. Eligible are post doctoral researchers having received their doctoral degree within the last five years. The fellowship can be combined with a post doc position elsewhere.

Please submit an application form (available at our website) together with a description of your research (1-5 pages), a curriculum

vitae, copies of the 1-4 most significant papers and 1-2 letters of recommendation (to be sent directly to the MFO by the respondents). Applications should be sent to the Vice Director, by email to [owrf@mfo.de](mailto:owrf@mfo.de), with attachments in pdf format.
