## Oberwolfach-Leibniz-Fellows

### Call for Application

Beginning in 2007, the Mathematisches Forschungsinstitut Oberwolfach (MFO) offers a new programme for post doctoral researchers in all fields of mathematics and its applications. In the initial phase 2007 - 2009, OWLF was sponsored by the Leibniz Gemeinschaft. Now it is included to the regular scientific programme of the MFO.

The focus of this programme "Oberwolfach-Leibniz-Fellows" is to support excellent young researchers (the doctoral degree or Ph.D. must be received within the last 5 years) in the stimulating atmosphere of the Oberwolfach Institute. The fellows must have active contact with a work group in a university or research institute including a positive perspective concerning a job or position after the stay at the MFO.

Applicants can apply with a research project for one or several stays at Oberwolfach of total duration between 2 and 6 months. The research can be carried out individually, in small groups with other fellows, or together with a senior researcher who may visit the MFO for shorter periods.

The Oberwolfach-Leibniz-Fellows are admitted to participate at the Oberwolfach workshops during their stay and may cooperate with researchers of the Oberwolfach "Research in Pairs"-programme. Moreover, the excellent library and good computing facilities of the MFO should guarantee a very efficient research stay.

The Institute will provide office space, accommodation (full board and lodging), and a post-doc-like financing during the stay at the MFO. Travel expenses can also be reimbursed up to a certain limit.

Applications can be made any time. Decision making requires usually about six weeks. Applicants should submit

- Application form (including dates for the proposed visit)
- Description of the research project (min. 3 pages, max. 10 pages)
- Curriculum Vitae
- Publication list
- Copies of the four most significant papers
- Recommendation letter of a senior researcher (including a confirmation for a positive job perspective)
- Two letters of recommendation (to be sent directly to the MFO by the respondents)

An application as an Oberwolfach Leibniz Fellow can also be arranged through an application within the European Post-Doctoral Institut (EPDI). More information (in particular, the application form) can be found on the website of the MFO: **[www.mfo.de](http://www.mfo.de)**
